

Poolside News Autumn 2017

Not such a bad year after all ! with early hot weather, low rainfall for the majority of the summer and what is showing signs of being a lovely late summer & Autumn, we've had lots of our regular customers telling us just how much use they have had from their pools and spas.

Of course most will continue to use their pools for some little while yet and Spas are for all the year round, but we've put together a few tips and ideas for future projects and Autumn refurbishments.

Don't forget to winterise...

Backwash & disinfect your filter.

Lower your Pool water level - if appropriate to your pool & it's equipment - a lot of pools with automatic safety covers need to be kept full - if you are not sure - ask for advice.

Add your Chemicals - again, this can differ depending on the pool & equipment - but most will need a shock treatment, a sanitiser and a good quality winter fluid to get them through the winter months.

Drain all vulnerable equipment - pumps, filters, heating, chemical dosing equipment and pipework that is likely to freeze and crack.


Switch off all power.

Cover the Pool - with a tight fitting winter debris cover to keep out winter debris and light.

Check your Pool at around Christmas time - the water may need to be lowered again & the chemical level checked.

Although last winter was remarkably mild with virtually no freezing weather at all, you can't rely on a repeat of that. Frozen pipes, frozen filtration equipment and frozen heating equipment cause endless amounts of damage to swimming pools and spas and the need to replace expensive equipment that could have prevented if it had been thought about and protected. Keeping the water clean over the winter months by using special winter fluid and keeping a low sanitiser reading will help to prevent work and big bills for cleaning up the next spring and make it much faster to open the pool up again when the spring comes.

Clean the pool well first of all - don't put it away dirty - it will be a lot worse in the spring when you try and open it up if you do.

Other services that we can offer whilst winterising your pool include for cleaning the swimming pool surround paving and coping using hot water pressure cleaners, changing the filter media in your pool filter - either for sand media or glass media and cleaning the sand filter media using chemicals.
